Standard Dixie tunes such as the *Tiger Rag*, *Basin Street Blues*, *Bourbon Street Parade*, *I've Found a New Baby*, *Yellow Dog Blues*, and *The Original Dixieland One-Step* are certainly in the repertoire. Favorite “oldies” that people love to hear and sing are also played (in our own jazz style), titles that include *When You're Smiling*, *Five-Foot Two*, *Somebody Stole My Gal*, *Bill Bailey* and *Shanty-Town* to name just a few. A number of audience pleasing “novelty” songs are also in the bands repertoire, such as *Blues My Naughty Sweetie Gives Me*, *Hungry Women*, and *The Charleston*, tunes that compliment the bands' lighthearted, often humorous on-stage demeanor.
